Tempranillo [Tinto Fino, Tinto del Pais, Tinto de Toro, Cencibel, Ull de Llebre]

Spain's principal native red grape, vinified on its own, makes a very attractive joven style wine with strawberry and raspberry aromas. Its finest examples however have always been in the great Riojas where it is generally used in a majority blend accompanied by Garnacha and Mazuelo. The resulting wine will age to Christmas-pudding, raisin-like, cinnamon richness in great years. At any level, particularly crianza and reserva, tempranillo can be spicy and complex and is considered Spain's answer to red Burgundy.

D.O.Ca Rioja

With three main sub regions of Rioja - Rioja Alavesa to the northwest and north of the river, Rioja Alta northwest and south of the river and Rioja Baja southeast and east of Logrono, each has its own style but all are considered classic Rioja. Alavesa is well known for producing thin skinned early ripening tempranillo which is great for early drinking wines with bright attractive fruit. In Rioja Alta where it is marginally hotter, tempranillo is thicker skinned and produces firmer structured wines often blended with Mazuelo (Carineña) and Graciano that adds freshness and aroma and they age with consummate grace. Finally Rioja Baja focuses on Garnacha.

D.O. Ribera del Duero

Ribera del Duero was initially put on the map by arguably the most famous name in Spanish wine, that of Bodegas Vega Sicilia. Initially bringing to the region the French grapes Cabernet and Merlot as well as small oak barrels and Bordeaux wine making skills it was soon discovered that with similar care, the local grape, Tinto Del Pais "country red" could produce similar peerless quality. The important thing to understand, like great Burgundy, there is no such thing as good cheap Ribera wine. Vineyard husbandry in this region is demanding. But as a result Ribera wines have a bold, bright character, packed with fruit are mouth-wateringly crisp with layers of vanilla and spice.

Bodegas Vega Sicilia

It's the name most people think of when thinking of Spanish wine, up there in fame as much as Rioja itself. It is another case of the legend preceding itself. Similar to that of DRC, Château Petrus, Guigal's 'La Turque' or even Grange, more wine lovers have heard of them than actually had the chance to experience them. By Vega Sicilia's own admission they are entirely unique wines, no other wine tastes like them, is made like them, or held for such a long time in the winery before release. Valbuena contains the highest proportion of Tempranillo with up 20% Merlot and some Malbec and is released after 5 years. Unico has about 20% Cabernet and some Malbec and released after 10 years with a minimum of 5 years in barrel and the same in bottle.

D.O. Toro

Tinto de Toro is the synonym used here for Tempranillo and it was planted sometime after the departure of the Moors. Tinto de Toro ripens about two weeks earlier than its cousins in Rioja. That coupled with its elevation results in a wine that is riper and has thicker skinned fruit, which in turn yields wine with considerable extract in terms of flavour, colour and strength. Garnacha is also grown here along with Cabernet Sauvignon although the latter is not permitted in any of the DO wines. Toro produces higher alcohol wines than most other region and can be mind-blowingly powerful, bold and bright.

D.O.Ca Priorat

There is plenty of traditions in Priorato, or as the Catalans call it Priorat, but more importantly there is also some seriously modern winemaking that produces some of the country's most hauntingly powerful, not to mention expensive red wines. Ever since the phylloxera epidemic a handful of producers started producing co-operative wines and names them all (5 in total) Clos-something and today there are among some of Spain's most sort after labels and recognised the world around. Garnacha and Carineña are the most important and some of the best come from seriously old vines. Cabernet, Merlot and Syrah are all permitted in red Priorat. The Garnacha usually takes up the majority of most blends and tends to be very low yielding making wines with power and concentration with generally high tannin and a distinct minerality from the prized schist soils.

Monastrell [Mouvèdre, Mataro] & blends

This grape variety, known as Mouvèdre in France and Australia and often called Mataro which is its Portuguese name, is an international variety and has an affinity to garnacha. But in Spain it is often used varietally and produces strong, dark, structured wines. It yields quite high but with care it produces vibrant fruit with delicious ripeness, lip smacking acidity and generous structure. The most successful examples come from Yecla and Mediterranean coastal Spain. The hall marks are intense morello cherries, balsamic, red fruit and often a hint of smokiness, made mostly for early drinking after seeing very little oak.

Mencia & Other Varieties

Mencia is Galicia's red grape variety grown throughout the Atlantic coastal areas with Valdeorras being the Eastern most region and Bierzo to west. From the Galician-Atlantic climate Mencia can be angular and sappy, a little like Pinot Noir; it is very light in cast and reflects its wet growing conditions by displaying gentle savoury and 'foresty' aromas. From Bierzo and a slightly more continental climate are slightly fleshier, more savoury wine with long soft tannin, but by no means big wines, you might find hints of smokey mineral schist from the unique soil of the hillside areas.

A.O.C. Chablis

The story goes that during the German bombing of the Second World War every time the Germans hit a building the locals would cheer as it inevitably meant they had missed a vineyard. So what makes Chablis so important and their vineyards so valuable? First of all its location: It is the most northerly and coolest appellation in Burgundy and secondly its unique Kimmeridgean limestone soil which is rich in fossils and ancient oyster shells. This results in a generally leaner, chalky incarnation of chardonnay, more in the mineral and nut vein than the stone fruit and honey of its southerly neighbours.

It is fair to say Domaine de la Romanee Conti (DRC) with a mere 26 hectares of vines are one of the most exclusive, rarest and most exquisite wines of the modern world. Yet for all its fame and expense the domaine runs quietly. All its practices, led by Aubert de Villaine are that of humble wine making traditions. There is no secret to their technique, it's 100% whole bunches, relatively cool fermentation, lightly toasted oak for 18 months on average, with a single racking and no fining or filtration. Nearly all the vineyards are managed organically and some biodynamically. The depth is in the terroir. Occupying the heart of Vosne-Romanée's grand cru appellations with vines aging from mid 30's to high 50's. In the wines from DRC's Echézeaux and Grands Echézeaux's you'll find a rarely matched meaty power. The Romanée-St-Vivant and Romanée-Conti are perfumed and seductive with great depth. Then finally Richebourg and La Tâche are packed full of substance with incredible fruit concentration, generous spice and enormous power.

There is no secret about the wines of Guigal. Their quality comes from the meticulous care and attention lavished upon them. Marcel Guigal believes in low yields, old vines and allowing grapes and their terroir their own freedom of expression with minimal interference. The pinnacle of the Guigal portfolio is undoubtedly the single vineyard Côte Rôtie wines affectionately known in the industry as the “La La’s” Each a different expression of Côte Rôtie – La Landonne is the powerhouse of them all - the Shiraz from this vineyard soaks up no less than 42 months in new oak and is all muscle. La Turque has about 7% Viognier and exhibits all kinds of spice and perfume and incredible concentration. Finally La Mouline is the most elegant of them all with a whopping 11% Viognier is silky textured and highly perfumed.

Bordeaux - The Right Bank

Where the Burgundians believe that if you take care of the nose the palate will look after itself, the Bordelaise are all about the mouth feel, weight, extract, intensity and length and then a quick fifteen to twenty years in the cellar and these wines reveal some of the most haunting aromas found in a glass.

Sangiovese

Tuscany is the home of Sangiovese and it is the dominant grape of the Chianti regions between Florence and Siena and as a single varietal (and generally regarded superior clone) in the highly prized Brunello di Montalcino. High in acid, sometimes astringent and with rustic aromas of sour cherry, herbs and spice, this variety, as is often the case, fits its regions cuisine perfectly. Food is mandatory and the more simple and traditional the better.

So when Piero Antinori started adding the non-traditional Cabernet to his blends in the 70's (after 600 years of traditional family winemaking) there were more than a few murmurings. With their new 'marketers dream name' and added plushness from the addition of the mostly Bordeaux varieties, these wine have quickly become some of the most sort after and highly prized wines in Italy.
